Minutes

This meeting follows on from a terminal visit on 19 April 2024.

1. Feedback and Skills Survey

GAL discusses headline points from a feedback and skills survey conducted of IGAP members. GAL thanks members for their contribution to the panel.

Members discussed the main themes from the feedback on the panel:

- Different ways of engaging between meetings to keep members updated after they give feedback on a project.
